Grand Council 2011

Grand Council was held May 20-22, 2011 in Sonora, CA. There was a good turn out of Grand Council Members this year and there was a very positive vibe the whole weekend! By Sublime Decree the new incoming Sublime Noble Grand Recorder is Fred "Suds" Ludemann. There was one new proctor appointed, Brian Nash. It was determined it was too soon to appoint someone to fill XSNGH Gene Browns proctor position after his sudden passing Monday May 16th just a few days before Grand Council so his position is currently vacant and will be addressed at the TRASH Trek in July.

One of the most anticipated discussions was about a possible Grand Council fee increases to \$200 per year, and possible new fee of \$10 per PBC's. It was decided that there would be no increase in Grand Council fees and no per PBC fee would be imposed.

There were some other issues discussed but those were the highlights. Our good friend Dingle even made an appearance! All in all it was a great weekend with a lot of good brothers!
