Doc Maynard Elections for New DJDK

Brothers,

In the past, the Officers and Greybeards of Chapter 54-40 have appointed the new incoming officers. Until this point we found it to be simple and affective, but the Chapter has grown significantly in the last few years. Since around this time last year the Greybeards have wanted to make some changes. We've been waiting for the bylaws to get finished, but haven't had time to have the bylaw committee meet and work out some of these specific details. One of those issues that we'd like to address now is the election of the new incoming Damn Fool Doorkeeper.

At the November and December Meetings we will be accepting nominations for Damn Fool Door Keeper. All members and associate members present will vote following the end of nominations at the December Meeting. Members being nominated **MUST BE PRESENT** to accept the nomination and **MUST BE A MEMBER OR ASSOCIATE MEMBER** in good standing with Doc Maynard Chapter 54-40 (Associate memberships will be available at the November and December meetings). Nominees must have been a brother for at least 1 year and attended at least one Doc Maynard Doin's since their initiation. **YOU MAY NOMINATE YOURSELF.** Following the acceptance of nominations but before voting the Greybeards will have an informational meeting with the nominees.

The new Damn Fool Doorkeeper will be announced at the Demotion Dinner in January.

Damn Fool Doorkeeper is the first officer chair that the newly elected member would hold while in the line to becoming Humbug. If Elected it is a 6 year commitment through Humbug.

Year 1 - Damn Fool Doorkeeper

Year 2 - Hangman

Year 3 - Gold Dust

Year 4 - Recorder

Year 5 - Vice Humbug (Attendance @ Grand Council Required)

Year 6 - Humbug (Attendance @ Grand Council Required)

Some of the responsibilities specific to this office include, being apprentice to the Hangman, Sergeant at Arms for the Chapter, attend all Meetings, attend all Parades, attend all Work Parties, and other functions at the request of the Officers or Greybeards.

Other Duties that fall on officers in general and are also included in this position, attending all Meetings, attending all Parades, and attending all Work Parties. Attendance at Grand Council is required when you are Vice Humbug and Humbug, but we request you attend all years to help support and run the chapter's hospitality suite, and help with the Hawker box. With Grand Council being held in Sonora California, we want to make sure you understand the financial investment and time requirements associated with this annual event for us Washingtonian's.

Helping with setup and tear down at Work Parties, Parades, Doins, and Widder's Balls is expected. An officers must have access to and be able to use a computer or email device, as many of the communications and events we put together are organized by email. He must represent the Chapter well in public, and at the many Work Parties and Parades we participate in. He must be able to organize and take charge of large groups when necessary. He must be responsible at times for Chapter funds and making proper deposits or purchases on the Chapter's behalf. He must be willing to front his own money at times, knowing it may be days before being reimbursed by the chapter due to logistics. He must also be willing to take on other duties at the request of the Officers and or Greybeards.

Please only accept a nomination if you are willing and able to handle this commitment! It can be stressful at times and time consuming. Please consider the stress this may cause for even the best Widder after 6 years, and the effects it may have on your family. We do realize at times you may be unable to attend a meeting, event, or function, due to work or family commitment. We fully support our brothers and their families at all times, but ask you to thoroughly consider if you are able to make the commitment.

If you go straight you'll be at WinCo Foods. To reach the cemetery take a left onto South 212th. The cemetery is on your immediate right hand side before you go over the overpass for Highway 167. If heading south on Highway 167, take the South 212th exit ramp and turn left onto South 212th. Go over the overpass. At the end of the overpass before you reach the light on your left hand side is the cemetery.
