Wilkeson Eagle Building Plaque

155th Anniversary of the Point Elliott Treaty

"Return to Muckl-te-oh"......1855 Point Elliot Treaty Commemoration

Last month Amy Johnson, great great granddaughter of Seattle pioneer David Denny & chairperson of the Descendants Committee of Seattle, contacted DM54-40 about the possibility of us helping out at a function that they were holding in Mukilteo, on the lighthouse grounds, commemorating the 155th anniversary of the signing of the Point Elliot Treaty, in which the Western Washington tribes ceded their lands to the U.S. government and

agreed to go to reservations. The Descendants Committee, realizing the screwing that the tribes took on this treaty, wanted to hold a gathering of the descendants of the signers, both White & Native in a reconciliatory spirit to acknowledge the past & to look to the future together. Apparently there were several Native speakers on the program that didn't get that memo & engaged in quite a bit of "White bashing" that was very inappropriate for the intended purpose of the event. At one point Cap'n Al became worried that his wildly unruly tresses might wind up on the wall in a lodge on the Res. Gordo, not sharing the same fear as Cap'n Al, offered to signal for help with reflection messaging. Fortunately we all escaped physically unscathed but wracked with guilt. The program was co-hosted by the Descendants Committee, MOHAI, Tulalip Tribes & the Mikilteo Historical Society. The Daughters of the American **Revolution & the Tukwila Historical Society also** had tables set up. Food was provided & a tree was planted at the end of the program to signify the growth of a new cooperative spirit. Good luck!


