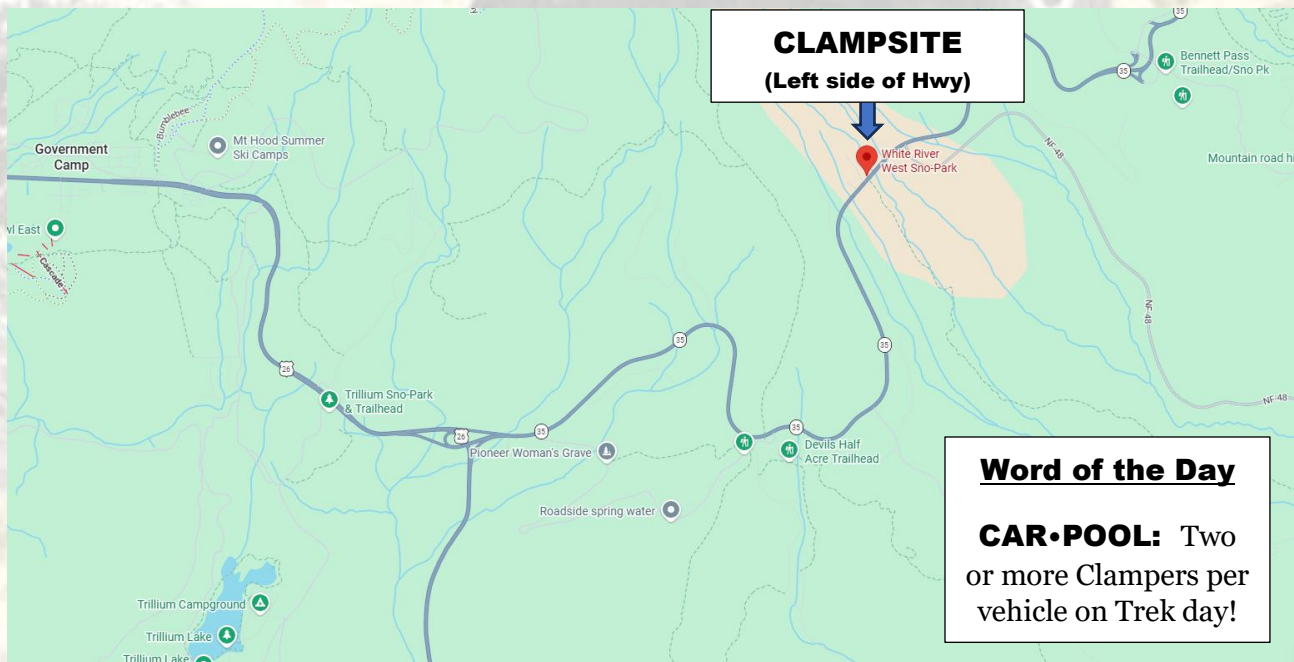
ANYONE VIOLATING THE NOTED REQUIREMENTS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE!

DIRECTIONS TO CLAMPSITE: WHITE RIVER WEST SNO PARK

White River West Sno Park is located on Oregon Hwy 35 approximately 4 miles north of US Highway 26. From Portland, travel east on Hwy 26 past the towns of Sandy and Gov't Camp. Continue traveling east on Hwy 26: take the Hwy 35 off ramp. Travel 4 miles further northeast on Hwy 35. Enter paved White River West SnoPark parking area on the left. Do not go to the Wh. R. East pkg area up and across Hwy 35. Look for ECV group camp. This is a big open parking lot. Tents may be erected back in woods just off the parking lot perimeter or directly on pkg lot pavement. Lost? Park and call the Head Abbot with a titling!
